Supplementary Questions on behalf of ICL Tech & ICL Plastics for Mr James McGoldrick

These questions are raised with a view to clarifying the position regarding the valve for the LPG pipework in the basement.

Our understanding is that Mr McGoldrick used to go down to the basement first thing in the morning to switch on the valve and he would switch it off last thing at night. This practice changed when ICL got a new LPG tank. Can Mr McGoldrick clarify the following:-

1. Was this the change of tank by Calor from the single tank to the two tanks in 1991 or was it when J Gas became suppliers of the LPG?

We understand the practice thereafter was for Mr McGoldrick to turn on the gas at the LPG tank in the yard.

2. Once the practice changed, was the valve in the basement removed or was it simply left permanently in the "on" position?
